




**SOME FEATURES OF THE BIOTECH SECTOR IN SPAIN:**

- Spain is the **2nd country worldwide** with the larger number of biotech related companies, according to the latest OECD data. **625 companies** are dedicated exclusively to biotechnology and more than **3,000 companies use biotechnology** in some of their processes.
- In 2012 the **number of jobs** in the sector as a whole was more than **200,000** and is 8,988 in biotechnology R&D. In terms of sectorial distribution, it is led by applications in the **food sector (68,5%)**, followed by those associated with **human health (19,7%)**.
- **World leader in biofuel** research and **marine biotechnology**.
- **European leader in clinical trials for advanced therapies** (source Molecular therapy, 2012).
- Biospain was the biggest country-based biotech event in Europe.
- Last year, ASEBIO members **launched 126 products or**



services and took part in **more than 200 alliances**. ● There are 82 drugs in Phase III, 90 in Phase II and 43 in Phase I, according to data from the Red Biotechnology Pipeline of ASEBIO 2014. Spain has the **8th largest pipeline** in Europe according to the last data of Beyond Borders Report. ● Ranked **3th in Europe** and **8th all over the world** in scientific publications in biotechnology according to the latest SCImago Country Rank data.
