4. Proposals considered

4.1 Applications in the area of pharmaceuticals

The committee considered application to import recombinant E. coli W, Sf9 cell line, Master virus stock (Baculovirus); pre-clinical toxicity study immunogenicity and safety evaluation of simian adenovirus vectored vaccine for COVID-19, recombinant Insulin Glargine. Biosimilar of Anakinra, a novel gene therapy product for Haemophillia A; pre-clinical toxicity study reports Romiplostim Injection in Sprague Dawley Rat, Chimeric Antigen Receptor CAR-T cells technology for cancer treatment.

4.2 Applications in the area of Agriculture

The Committee considered applications the request to change the exporter detail; Event selection trial under confined field condition for GE Pigeonpea expressing *Cry2Aa*, *Cry1AcF* gene. After deliberation on each application including information items, appropriate decision was taken by the RCGM.

5. IBSC Reports

The Committee considered minutes submitted by twelve IBSCs minutes of the meeting, Nil annual compliance reports and medical surveillance report, and appropriate decision was taken by the RCGM.

6. Other items

The Committee considered expert committee comments on mRNA vaccines on Covid-19 and request for extension of permission to store the transgenic maize seeds.

No other transaction took place and the meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
