The committee considered applications to import Coronavirus 2-Isolate, SARS-CoV-2 isolate, MemVax adjuvant, recombinant human adenovirus 5; to receive SARS-CoV2 strains; to export bacterial, yeast, and fungal isolates; pre-clinical toxicity study reports on Ranibizumab biosimilar, Coronavirus Vaccine (rDNA)—CoroRab; monthly progress report on Handling of COVID-19 strain CDX-005 at enhanced BSL-2,; request for Removal of Drosophila from DGFT list of restricted items for import licensing. After deliberation on each application including information items, appropriate decision was taken by the RCGM.

4.2 Applications in the area of Agriculture

No complete application submitted for consideration by RCGM.

5. IBSC Reports

The Committee considered minutes submitted by ten IBSCs, Nil annual compliance reports and Nil medical surveillance report, and appropriate decision was taken by the RCGM.

6. Other items

The Committee considered request on disposal of voucher GE seed samples conserved from imported transgenics seeds, draft document on biorepositories and draft document on list of infective microorganisms and appropriate decision was taken by the RCGM.
