#### MINUTES OF THE 206th MEETING OF THE REVIEW COMMITTEE ON GENETIC **THROUGH MANIPULATION** (RCGM) HELD $\mathbf{ON}$ 13.05.2021 **VIDEO** CONFERENCING

The Chairman, RCGM extended a formal welcome to the members of the RCGM for the 206<sup>th</sup> meeting and initiated the process of the meeting. The list of participants is given at Annexure-I.

- On action taken report, the Member-Secretary informed that during the 205th meeting of 3. the RCGM, a total of 35 applications including information items were considered and the Secretariat is in the process of issuing requisite permit letters based on the recommendations of the RCGM.

#### 4. **Proposals considered**

#### 4.1 Applications in the area of pharmaceuticals

The committee considered applications to import SARS CoV2 strains; pre-clinical toxicity study of recombinant SARS-CoV-2 RBD protein, recombinant human epidermal growth factor, Protein subunit vaccine directed against Recombinant Receptor binding domain (RBD) and Nucleocapsid protein (N) of the SARS-CoV-2 virus; pre-clinical toxicity study reports on Trastuzumab biosimilar, recombinant Liraglutide, Adjuvanted Corona Virus Vaccine (rDNA)for COVID-19; progress report on change in required biosafety level from BSL-3 to enhanced BSL-2 and further request for consideration of revising the Enhanced BSL-2 requirements to BSL-2. After deliberation on each application including information items, appropriate recommendations were made by the RCGM.

### 4.2 Applications in the area of Agriculture

The Committee considered application to conduct Biosafety Research Level-I confined field trials of GE cotton. After deliberation on each application including information items, appropriate recommendations were made by the RCGM.

## 5. IBSC Reports

The Committee considered minutes submitted by six IBSCs, Nil annual compliance reports and Nil medical surveillance report, and appropriate recommendations were made by the RCGM.

## 6. Other items

The Committee deliberated on the request submitted by NIV, Pune for IBSC of ICMR-NIV, Pune and its three field units (Kerala, Bangalore, Mumbai) and made appropriate recommendations were made by the RCGM.
