- **No Access:** FASTQ files, Population names, Mapping of population codes to population names, GPS coordinates of locations where samples were collected.

The GI metadata for FASTQ files will include sample_description, state in India the sample is collected, environmental_context, sequencing_method, library_name, etc. The metadata for VCF files will include: Sample Name, Reference (Reference the analysis was performed against.), Software, Pipeline Description, Imputation, Centre, Age, and sex.
