The objectives of the AISRF are to increase the uptake of leading-edge science and technology (S&T) by supporting collaboration between Australian and Indian researchers in strategically focused, leading-edge scientific research and technology projects, and strengthening strategic alliances between Australian & Indian researchers; and facilitate India's and Australia's access to the global S&T system. The call for applications for **Round 16** is open and will close on **11**th **April 2025**.
